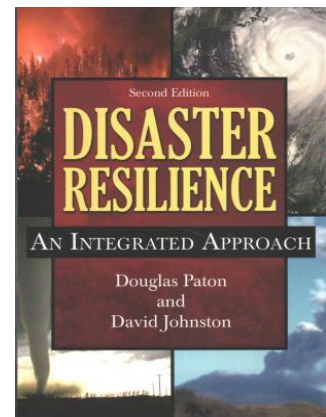


Call for Papers – A tribute to Professor Douglas Paton

The Australasian Journal of Disaster and Trauma Studies has been publishing research and commentaries on social aspects of natural hazards, disasters, and disaster-related trauma for academic and practitioner audiences since 1997. This journal recognises the multi-disciplinary nature of research and practice into social dimensions of disasters and disaster-related trauma. It seeks to attract contributions from academics and practitioners from diverse disciplinary and professional backgrounds, including mental health and wellbeing, physical and geological sciences, social sciences, and health and welfare services.



The journal founder, Professor Douglas Paton, has had a long career during which he substantially advanced our understanding of community resilience to disaster. As a tribute to him a special issue of the Australasian Journal of Disaster and Trauma Studies will bring together accounts of the research, policy and practice initiatives from researchers and practitioners that is based on and/or builds upon his work. The resulting special issue will be published online, with open access at no cost to authors or readers. Papers received and reviewed early will be available as an online version ahead of the complete special issue.

01/02/2022 – Deadline for Identifications of interest using the form available as a Word doc on the journal website (<http://trauma.massey.ac.nz/>) or from the Managing Editor (l.vinnell@massey.ac.nz) to provide proposed title, authors, paper type, and brief summary of proposed content (100 – 200 words)

01/06/2022 - Manuscript submission deadline for accepted Identifications of Interest

01/09/2022 - Initial review outcome to authors

01/12/2022 - Revision deadline

01/05/2023 - Publication of the special issue of the Australasian Journal of Disaster and Trauma Studies
